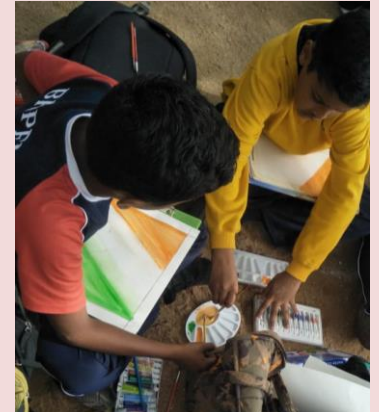
Name of the Activity & Date : Independence Day Painting , 02/08/2023

### Name of the Activity : "Kannada ulisi, kannada belasi"

#### Objective :

##### "Kannada ulisi Kannada belasi"

The earliest form of kannada script is found in the halmidi inscription dated 450AD. Many of the badami chalukayan records in Sanskrit are written in this script. The kannada script has been continuously and the present kannada script is the result of such evolutionary changes for over 2500 years.

Constitution of India provides for States to adopt anyone of the Languages as official language for official or any other purpose. Accordingly in the state of Karnataka Kannada Language was adopted as the official language. With the object of developing the regional or official language namely Kannada, the State of Karnataka has enacted The Karnataka Official Language.

Despite aforesaid enactments, notifications and orders, there is no much progress in proper implementation of the official Language in the State. The Kannada Language has been introduced as one of the Language subject in Schools but there is no proper provision for learning of Kannada Language in the Higher or Technical or Professional Education.

Due to lack of co-ordination between various departments, there is a failure in implementation and usage of Kannada language in Offices, Industries, Shops and Establishment etc.

#### Description:

##### The salient features of proposed legislation Kannada as regional language

- (i) Introduction of Kannada as one of the language in Higher or Technical or Professional Education.
- (ii) (ii) Reservation in Higher, Technical and Professional Education to persons who have studied in Kannada medium
- (iii) (iii) Introduction of Kannada as essential Language for seeking employment in the State Government, Local Authorities, Statutory and non-statutory bodies, Co-operative Societies and other societies in the State.
- (iv) Use of Kannada Language in Sub-ordinate Courts, Tribunals, Banks and other Financial Institutions.
- (v) General Measures to be taken for Extensive use and Propagation of Kannada Language
- (vi) Measures to be taken for use of Kannada Language in information and technology and in software development.

Climate change is the significant variation of average weather conditions becoming, for example, warmer, wetter, or drier—over several decades or longer. It is the longer-term trend that differentiates climate change from natural weather variability.

#### **\*Windmill:**

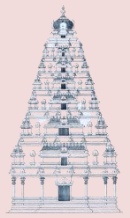
#### **\*Save Earth Save Water:**

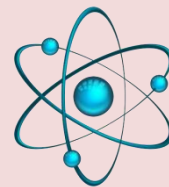
- Pupils are able to understand the meaning, types and importance of folklore.

Name of the Activity : \*Lime water turns milky, \*Conductivity of metals and non-metals, \*Energy associated with a pendulum.

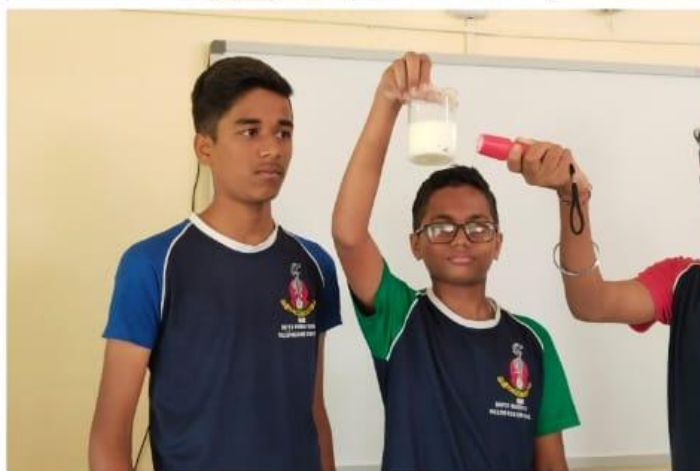
### **Objective :**

- \* **Lime water turns milky** : This reaction shows the presence of carbon dioxide.
- \* **Conductivity of metals and non- metals**: This activity proves that metals are good conductors of electricity.
- \* **Energy associated with a pendulum**: This activity shows the energy possessed by pendulum when it is at rest and in motion.

### **Description:**

- \* **Lime water turns milky**: \*Pour the freshly prepared lime water into two test tubes labelled A and B.
- \*With the help of a glass tube, blow air in the test tube labelled B.
- \* Using a syringe fitted with a rubber tube, pass air through the lime water in the test tube labelled A.
- \* The lime water in test tube B turns milky in no time showing that we exhale carbondioxide.
- \***Conductivity of metals and non- metals** : \* A simple circuit is made by connecting one end of the torch to cell and other end end of torch to metal strip and to cell back .
- \* Let us insert a piece of iron nail between the wires and we will observe.
- \* Repeat the same activity with a wooden piece between the wires.
- \* In case of iron nail, we observe that , bulb glows in the circuit and in case of wooden piece, bulb doesn't glow.
- \* **Energy associated with a pendulum**: \* Take a simple pendulum and displace the bob from position A to B. We can see the pendulum oscillating to and fro due to kinetic energy.
- \* After some time, the bob comes to rest due to air friction and now possesses potential energy.

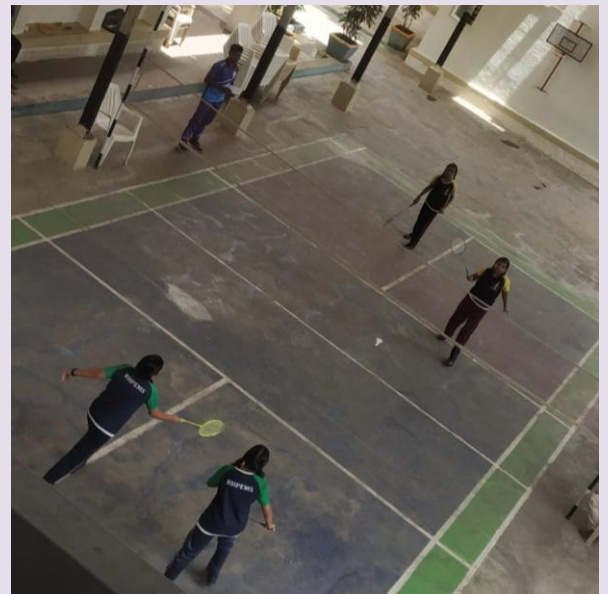

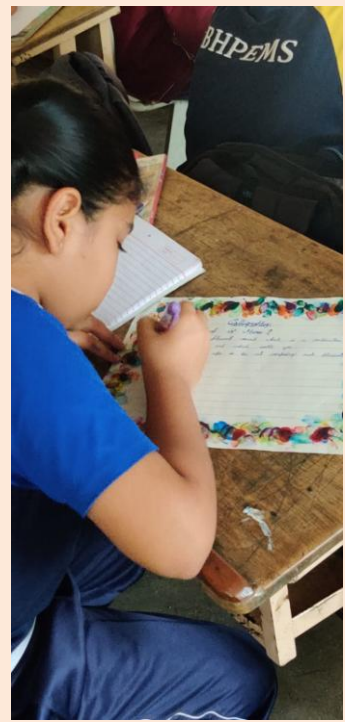
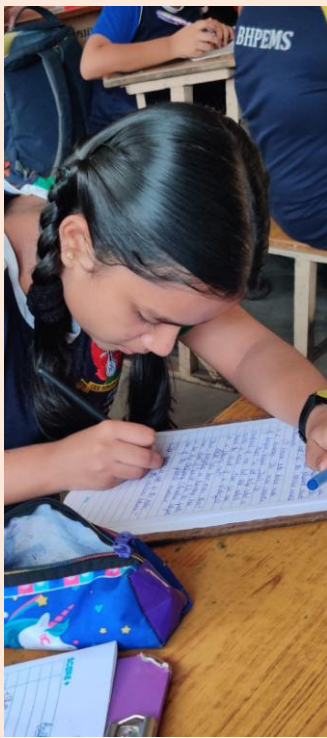
