The objective of compost activity is to recycle organic waste into a valuable resource that can be used to improve soil health and fertility. Composting has many environmental and economic benefits.

Reduces methane emissions from landfills. Methane is a greenhouse gas that is 25 times more potent than carbon dioxide at trapping heat in the atmosphere. When organic waste is composted, it breaks down anaerobically, which produces methane. However, when organic waste is composted aerobically, methane emissions are significantly reduced.

Reduces the need for chemical fertilizers. Compost is a natural fertilizer that can provide plants with the nutrients they need to grow healthy. This can help to reduce the need for chemical fertilizers, which can pollute waterways and harm the environment.

Description: Compost is decomposed organic material. Compost is made with material such as leaves, shredded twigs, and kitchen scraps from plants. To gardeners, compost is considered "black gold" because of its many benefits in the garden. Compost is a great material for garden soil.
